

Out of Hours Pharmacy at Litherland Town Hall Health Centre

From 1 April 2015, the Out of Hours Pharmacy will be replaced with a new system, so you'll still be able to get all the urgent medicines you need after seeing a doctor from the GP Out of Hours service:

- **Take your prescription to a nearby chemist** - your doctor will give you details of which ones close by are open late weekdays and weekends.
- **When these are closed** - the doctor will give you any medicines you need during your consultation, mainly late night at weekends and bank holidays.
- **If you can't travel** - your doctor will supply any medicines you need at any time during the out of hours period.
